About the Programs we offer:

Small Fry

(Ages 4 & 5)

Designed for our youngest members, this program offers a variety of age-appropriate activities such as both indoor and outdoor games, crafts, story-telling, singing, now tennis & swim lessons. There are occasional "field trips" to the beach and other local venues where a permission slip will be required and volunteers for chaperoning are encouraged. Sandpipers 6

(Ages 6 by June 1st)

This program offers a variety of age-appropriate activities such as indoor and outdoor games, crafts, story-telling, singing, tennis & swim lessons. There are occasional "field trips" to the beach and other local venues where a permission slip will be required and volunteers for chaperoning are encouraged. Additional field trip fee may be required.

Sandpipers 7

(Age 7 - Child must be age 7 by June 1st)

In addition to what Sandpiper program typically offers, our 7-year old children will have the opportunity to learn how to sail! Sailing lessons will be offered Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., as part of this Sandpiper program! Club's optis will be used for this program at no extra cost to the participant!

Duties

The indoors program assistant instructor will report to the indoors program director

The indoors program instructor will be assisting/supporting the overall running of the Small Fry, Sandpipers and other indoor programs, including the following:

- Helping to run an instructor orientation
- Keep track of camper dietary restrictions and allergies and ensure proper snacks/meals are distributed to each camper.
- Coordinate camp's daily schedule of activities and manage transitions to ensure timely arrival of your camp in between activities.
- Facilitate group activities for your campers during free periods.
- Report any notable concerns or incidents to indoors program director.

Daily/Weekly Job Responsibilities

- Assist with the care and supervision of all campers
- Engage in activities which build physical, mental, emotional, and social skills
- Establish a safe, healthy, and comfortable environment for the children.
- Supervise activities for the children
- Interact with children during planned activities and child-directed activities (free play, outside/gym time, etc.).
- Encourage children to be independent by having them do things for themselves, including cleaning up after themselves.
- Encourage children to respect each other.
- Responsible for positive guidance techniques which foster the child's ability to be selfdisciplined.
- Encourage children to vent frustrations or hostilities without hurting themselves or others.
- Evaluate children's developmental growth on a regular basis.
- Notify the Indoors Program Director when a child has an accident, exhibits unusual behavior, or displays signs of illness, and fill out appropriate forms, as required.
- Other related responsibilities may be assigned by the direct supervisor as needed.

Position Requirements:

- At least 1-2 years of experience with childcare, teaching or camp counseling required.
- First Aid & CPR/AED certifications (maybe offered on site)
- Maintain a positive and energetic attitude
- Be passionate about entertaining youth and developing team spirit
- Proven track record of superior organization and multi-tasking
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Must be able to participate in potentially strenuous physical activity
- Demonstrated skills in conflict mediation
