CK Mondavi Selection - 6.25

Chardonnay, Pinot Grigio, Sauvignon Blanc, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot Noir

Wines offering both tremendous quality and value

Chardonnay, Joel Gott, Barrel Aged, Santa Barbara, California - 12.50

Smooth, balanced and beautifully complex, this Chardonnay wowed the committee with its aromas of ripe pear, apples, and peaches with notes of honeysuckle and baking spices

Chardonnay, Rombauer, Carneros, California - 20.00

Full-bodied, rich, buttery, and fruit-forward, intense aromas of yellow peach, ripe melon, and vanilla, combined with creamy, toasty oak notes and a long, vibrant finish

Sauvignon Blanc, Terres Blanches, Maison de la Madeleine, Sancerre, France - 15.00

Flinty minerals, white peach, sherbet and herbal accents. The palate is refreshing and complex, with a silky texture

Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita, Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy - 14.00

Medium bodied, clean, intense aroma of Golden Delicious apples, citrus, and hints of almond, crisp, bright acidity and a lingering, multi-layered finish

Rosé, Danica, Provence, France - 9.00

Delicate blend of crisp white peach, fresh-cut melon, tart strawberry, and hibiscus, balanced by mineral notes, zesty citrus peel, and a lingering, silky finish.

Tempranillo/Graciano, Marqués de Riscal Rioja Reserva, Spain - 16.00

Rich, refined and full of character, this Spanish red was the outstanding favorite among the red wines. Boasting an intense black-cherry hue with enticing aromas of licorice, cinnamon, and black pepper

Cabernet Sauvignon, Oberon, Napa Valley, California - 15.00

Medium to full bodied, black cherry, candied blackberry, and cassis, complemented by undertones of coffee, dark chocolate, and spicy oak
